We have added a third service at the Eastham Unit they; have a new chapel which was built in the gym and it holds over 300 inmates and the old chapel is being used now for what they call the South side, the gym for the North side and the trustee camp. We have been at that Unit several times this month and the meetings all fill up. We had some saved, backsliders sell out to the Lord, some healed, and the Lord has me pray for those who recently lost a loved one while in prison as they cannot go to the funerals and I understand what it is like now to have lost a loved one. Of course I have anointed singers, and some of our team share a word of encouragement to the prisoners, which makes for a complete service of love, which is the greatest thing that draws them to the Lord. Those of you who receive this newsletter have a wonderful part you can have by financially and prayerfully supporting this ministry. This ministry has existed for 32 years by faith and that's the way we will continue to go on. However God has called an army of saints to accomplish his work and without you doing your part the work suffers and you could be missing out on God's blessings. We are also in need of a new 15 passenger van as our team is growing and my van has 166,689 miles on it. All prisons are way out in the sticks except 2 in Huntsville that is in the city itself. We are also over \$10,000 short since the beginning of the year and we could use your support. If everyone receiving this could send from their heart, we would never get behind. We are so appreciative for all our supporters and we pray that the Lord blesses each of you abundantly for your sacrifice! We love all of you!


WHAT IS OUR HOPE
