We arrived at Hilltop Prison, Gatesville, Tx. around 9 a.m. on Friday 6th Feb. 2015. After clearing security we went dorm to dorm to visit and share with the inmates. We first met with the women in G1 dorm. First off there was the mother of the dorm, a very wonderful woman of God, waiting to be paroled soon. The woman blessed us indeed with her faith and knowledge of the Word. The other women made a great impact on my life listening to them share not only the Word but also some went into small details of their incarceration. One cannot help but have love and compassion for these. To hear them speak, to see their tears and genuine Godly sorrow is amazing. I could feel their love and pain at the same time. Yet they are happy with the joy of the Lord and his peace. Trusting and believing to be paroled and return to their families and continue the assignment God had placed in their hearts to do. Later that same day, at the 1 p.m. and 6 p.m. services, I could see and feel not only in the natural but also in the Spirit and Supernatural the presence of the Lord in the Chapel. The deep hunger in the inmates for the Word of God was so evident. The healing of their soul, hurts, deliverance and praying for their families. Many gave their lives to the Lord and those who were already Christians were wanting more and more from God. On Saturday a.m. we returned to visit and minister again. Evangelist Tom Harris, thru the Holy Ghost, chose three of us to go into Death Row. Minister Sheila, Sr. Diane, Evang. Gail. I believe this to be a divine appointment, I did not say, but I felt like Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego and privileged on this assignment. We went in to minister but the two women on death row ministered us to. It was an awesome atmosphere charged with the presence of the Holy Spirit. We could not say anything for a while. They needed to talk and share as the Lord led them. Only upon release by the Spirit we were able to share...this was a life changing experience for me. In spite of the fact that they are facing the death penalty, they have resigned themselves to the will of God. It amazed me how full of the Holy Spirit and enriched with the Word, the peace of God and the Anointing, the joy of the Lord, yes, the sad moments but overall contented in Him. When we left to rejoin the team I felt so blessed and on fire, full of the Glory of the Lord. Praise the Lord for His tender mercies and grace. We then went dorm to dorm again, and again such great faith and hunger in the women. At the 1 p.m. and 6 p.m. Services the move of God was evident and again chains were broken and lives changed and redirected. The Word, testimonies and singing went forth each time powerful and accomplishing God's purpose for this ministry to the inmates. I do believe the revival that is coming out of the Prison Ministry will have an impact on the world. These women are truly ready and equipped to now go work the works of God as Jesus commanded us to do!!!!!! I give God all the glory, all the praise for the work done over the weekend. I pray these women will increase in strength and faith for the Kingdom.

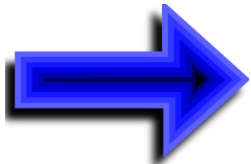
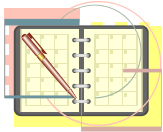

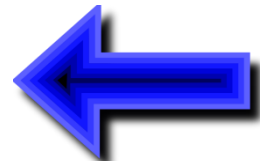

To while away the hours.*

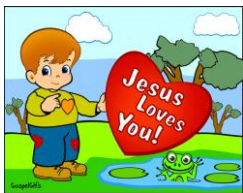
*His gift was to become a man,
