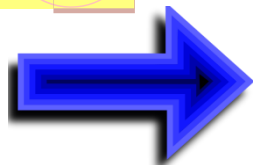
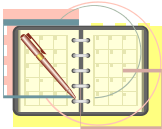

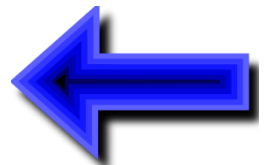

NEEDS OF THE MINISTRY:

The ministry needs a brand new 15 passenger van. He shall be like a tree planted by the waters . . . ; its leaf will be green. — Jeremiah 17:8

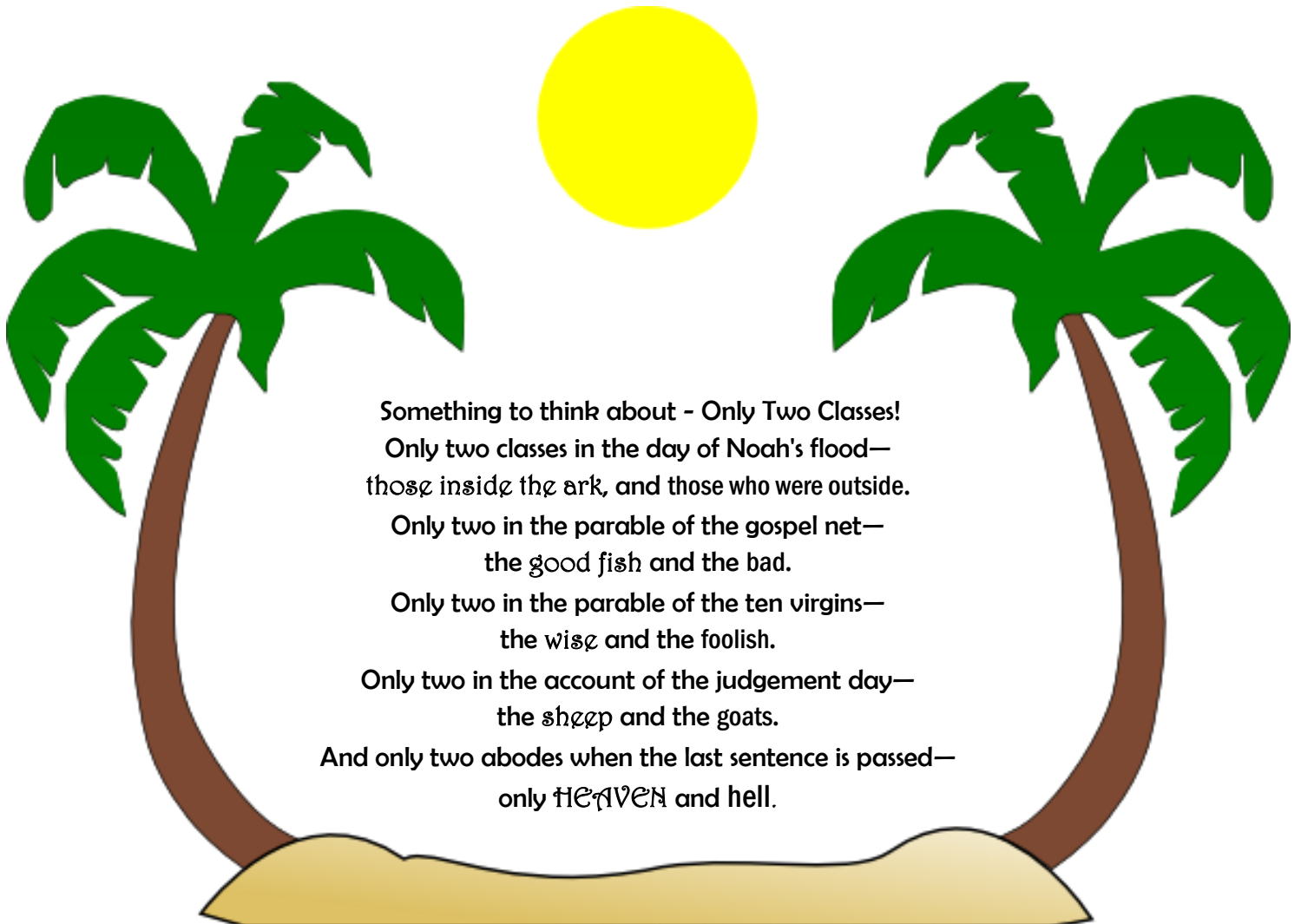
