On 2nd of May 2021, Chaplain Shelia Johnson and brother Dan Groves went into the W.E. Ramsey unit, (after Covid testing). With 1 hour limit, The Holy Spirit empowered us to lead the men in Worship as Chaplain Shelia Johnson sang and gave scriptural exhortation. Brother Dan preached on Knowing God, intimately. Afterward, we had more worship led by Chaplain Johnson and prayer for those wanting to rededicate their lives to Jesus.

RUFUS H DUNCAN UNIT: May 15, 2021, I went into this unit representing the Hope For All In Jesus Prison Ministry. I gave a message in 2 services and because of the virus, the number of inmates is limited to 25 for each service. Each



service was opened by the units' worship team, and I sang 'God Will Make Away' and 'You Gotta Live Like God's Gonna Use Ya' playing my guitar before giving the message. Today's message was 'The Mind Is A Battlefield' and I taught them that negative thinking was not from the Lord but the enemy of our soul. The Holy Spirits' presence was so strong in these services that no one wanted to leave.

Chaplain Linda Rogers has been the volunteer chaplain

since 2005. Her story is that she was an inmate for 24 years and grew in her walk with the Lord during that time. The Lord made her aware that she was to be involved with prison ministry when released, but she did not want to be involved in this prison because she grew up in this area. She tried to be involved in different prisons for a while but no doors opened for her, and finally gave in to the fact that the Diboll Unit was where the Lord wants her. She has been the volunteer chaplain for 16 years at this unit. Minister John P Hammond



On May 23rd 2021, Pastor Keeley Ware-Bryant and myself went to the Estelle Unit in Huntsville, Texas. To Minister the word to the inmates. We did three services back-to-back. In the first service we had a total of 22 inmates (due to Covid Restrictions only 20 were allowed) thank you Jesus they allowed 2 extra. The inmates did a wonderful job of leading praise and worship and they opened in prayer. I opened up with spiritual encouragement in both Spanish and English telling the men that they are special, because they are

made in the image of GOD. (Genesis 1:26) Then Pastor Keeley, brought the word from Philippians 1:6 which was received very well by the men. She then made an altar call for anyone wanting to rededicate their life to Jesus (2 men lifted their hands)

In the second service I gave my testimony about God's faithfulness and his keeping power and how he has answered prayer in my life. Then I told them they are SON's of GOD and no longer servants (Galatians 4:6-8) The men received the word, then Pastor Keeley sang "he knows my name", and she asked the men if there was anyone there who wanted to rededicate their life to Jesus and receive salvation. (5 men rededicated their lives and 2 received salvation) We had 25 men in attendance . All glory to God. The third service was held in the chapel with social distancing and Covid Restrictions, but we wound up with 27 men in attendance. In every service the men told us how much they have missed Hope For All In Jesus Prison Outreach and asked if Pastor Robert had really passed. They also asked for Minister Sheila Johnson and the Team. One man stated he had not been to any kind of service in a while and he only came because he heard that Hope For All In Jesus was going to be there, he also stated that no one else has come to minister the unadulterated word of God so he told Pastor Keeley and I how much he appreciated us bringing the word. It made us feel good. We both preached at this service. Pastor Keeley gave an altar call and prayer over all the men and we had 6 men rededicate their lives and 2 salvations. They prayed for us before we left, and we were so honored by the love these men showed us as representatives of The Hope For All In Jesus Prison Outreach. Both Sister Keeley and I commented to each other how the early wake up to come to minister to the men was well worth it. God's blessings -Sister Gloria Johnson

On May 23rd, 2021, at the Oliver T. Bell Unit, (formerly known as the Cleveland Unit), a double team consisting of Chaplain Shelia Johnson / Evangelist Tom Harris of Gospel Blimp International and minister John Hammond / brother Dan Groves. Evangelist Tom Preached on the one side and Minister John Hammond Preached on the other side. Brother Dan Groves

On May 30th 2021 we had four prisons scheduled: I was able to send Pastor Keely and Dennis Ware to Pam Lychner with a last minute call. Dan and John went to Jester IV, Joy and George went to the Duncan unit and I went to the Eastham Unit. One volunteer was sick and could not go, so I went alone.

At Eastham, I forgot that there are four services that day. When I finished the first service everyone asked me if I was leaving and I told them yes, only to find out that no one else was coming for the rest of the services. I was expected to conduct all the services. Well thanks be to God I was able to do three services back-to-back. They brought me lunch from the chow hall and it was good. Because there was a long gap to the last service, the Chaplain covered it for me. Each service allowed forty-four men plus eight that were on the praise team and three running the sound system. About 7 men came up to rededicate their lives to Christ. Saints, that's what it's all about saving souls. Chaplain Shelia Johnson

On May30th, 2021 On a last-minute change, Minister John Hammond and brother Dan Groves were sent to Jester IV Unit. The place was small but all the seats, 21 in all were filled with men eager to participate in the sharing of the Word. There was no Worship team or equipment, and John led worship with Spirit filled music on his guitar and gave an encouraging word. Dan gave the message on Spiritual warfare and the secret and effective weapons that can be found throughout the pages of our Bible. Afterward, we gave an invitation for Salvation and rededication. One man wanted to give his life to the Lord, (again), and we included him with the five others who raised their hands to rededicate their lives to Jesus. John led in the prayer and afterward closed in prayer. Brother Dan Groves

On May 30th, 2021 George and Joy Powell went into Duncan Unit to minister. Here is their report: When we first got to the unit, of course we had to get tested for COVID. Both of us passed so we were allowed to go inside. The number of attendees was about 1/2 of what we usually have and that was a result of COVID. We opened up with a word of prayer and then I started the service. The men seemed a little down and quite reserved and I knew that I had to do something to perk things up. So I began by involving them with the first song. We all sang "Hallelujah, Praise Ye The Lord". This is the sort of song that you can have fun with and change it up, so I did. This brightened up their spirits and put smiles on their faces. Yeah. Then I sang "Oh Buddha". Sister for Powell

If you don't know that song, google it and read the words. It is a peppy song. Then I sang "Leaning Place". This is a slower song and the words of it pull the listener in and really speaks to their hearts. Then George opened up the Word to Psalm 56:10-11, King James Version. It says: **10)** In God will I praise his word: in the Lord will I praise his word. **11)** In God have I put my trust: I will not be afraid of what man can do unto me.He began pouring out the truths of scripture to them and they were quite receptive to it. God is so good even to us who truly do not deserve it and for that, I bless His Name.
