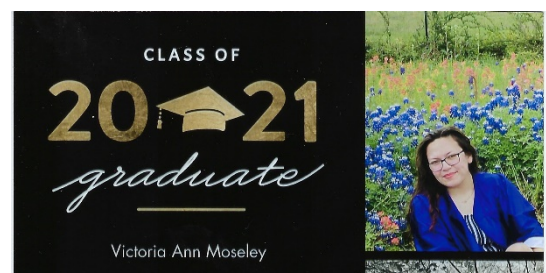

On 6th of June 2021, At Clemens Unit, Pastors Leonard and Cynthia Ventress ministered at Clemens Trustee Camp. There were about 25 men in attendance. The presence of the Holy Spirit could immediately be felt in the place, as the men began to worship. Their praise and worship team is outstanding...men who truly love God.

Pastor Leonard preached on answering God's call. He was wearing a shirt with the image of a cell phone screen that read "Jesus Calling...". and an "Accept" or "Reject" button. One of the brothers there had previously shared, "If you don't respond to the invitation, you can't come to the party".

It was a simple and yet powerful message. Just like the famous painting of Jesus knocking on the door that has no doorknob on his side. The doorknob is only on the inside. We have to open it. We have to accept the call. We have to invite Jesus in.

A show of hands revealed that everyone there was saying they had already let Jesus into their hearts. We prayed with them as a group, and closed the service in worship.

As we come to bring a blessing, it never fails that we, ourselves, are blessed.

On June 13th At Carol Young Unit, Chaplain Shelia Johnson and sister Vanessa Woods attended the Carol Young Unit in Dickerson. The spirits of the women were high and uplifting. On June 20th At PAM LYNCHNER STATE JAIL – Hope For All In Prison Outreach went into this unit with



Dan Groves and me ministering the service. Dan encouraged the inmates with a word to become more like Jesus using, Philippians 2:5 (KJV) "Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus". He informed them that reading the Bible daily like you eat food is how to grow and become more like Jesus. I brought my acoustic guitar and led the men in worship and gave the message, The Mind Is the Battlefield teaching them that according to 2 Corinthians 10:3-4 "we live in the world, but we do not wage war as the world does. The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds". I taught them that if they seek the Lord while in here, they will realize that they are there for training. If they give God their time studying the Word, spending quiet time with Him in prayer, they will learn what is needed to live free of crime. All 12 men in this service confirmed they were born again and Dan closed the service with a prayer that men will draw closer in their relationship with the Lord. Afterward, we had a time of testimony. The men were greatly encouraged and seemed reluctant for the service to end. Minister, John P Hammond.

On June 20th at Estelle Unit Vanessa and I had the pleasure of conducting worship service. The men opened up with an encouraging scripture, a song and prayer. Vanessa sang two songs and I ministered on the message "The Safest Place In the Whole Wide World (WWW) is Under the Blood of Jesus". Initially we were to conduct four services but due to one group being in quarantine we only had three services. Vanessa ministered in the second service and I ministered on "Have You Been Tried in the Fire?" in the third service. There were a number of men that came up for prayer during the services. On June 27th At Jester IV Unit, Brother Dan Groves went to this unit and was let in early since he didn't need to be Covid tested. We opened in prayer, and I taught the men a couple songs from Ps 100 and Ps 150. We had a lot of fun and came into the manifestation of our heavenly Fathers presence. I brought the Word in continuance of last month's message about Spiritual Warfare. Beginning with 1 Peter 5, Eph 6, and several scriptures showing spiritual weapons and how they are used. We also talked about some of the equipment of the Spiritual Armor. We had a good time of testimonies including some of my own. Those from last month returned for a total of 25. Brother Derreck there, is an inmate ministering from cell to cell. Pray, God leads him to souls for salvation & redemption.



On June 27th At Ramsey Unit, Sunday, I ministered at the Ramsey Unit in Brazoria County for two services. The chaplain informed me the old cafeteria has now been donated by the prison to accommodate the chapel. The large room had recently been painted by the inmates from a grey to white which certainly brightened the room. In addition, several rooms connected were in the process of being changed into classrooms for training and Bible studies according to the chaplain. This unit has just recently opened up to allow church services and for this reason, I was asked to give the message for two services. I was told they have a worship team but because of the virus, the attendance is limited they weren't in these services. I had brought my guitar and led the worship service before giving the message "Get Acquainted With Your Heavenly Father". The men were very attentive and said they were thankful that I made them aware of who God is to them. All confessed to knowing Jesus as their savior and our prayer

Most people think there may be some danger in going into these prisons, however, because of the security, that is the last thing to be concerned about. The truth is when I minister in these units the men always show appreciation by thanking me for coming and believe I am more blessed than they are when I leave.

On June 27th At Estelle Unit, Chaplain Shelia Johnson and minister Ray Felder went to the Estelle Unit on 27 June 2021. We had four services. They allowed at least 40 to attend each service. The men were glad to see us as we were welcomed by all. We had several of the men on the praise team to open each service with praise and worship. One of the Chaplains Assistant ministered in the first service. Ray ministered in the second and last service and I ministered in the third service. There were at least ten men that came forward either for salvation or rededication of their life to Christ. We also had lunch in their officers' dining room (ODR). We were told that when they get 70% vaccinated that they may completely open up so that the services will be as before COVID-19. Praise God!
