Dan brought an exhortation/encouragement and Vanessa gave the message about the Seed, the Bread, and the Harvest. Of those who came up for prayer, some were for help to remain faithful and others were for family. It's a helpless feeling to be locked away, unable to provide the support your family needs.

Eastham unit, The Lord truly blessed the service at the Wainwright unit on Jun 19th. Apostle Ray C. Felder and I were accompanied by Evangelist Noe and Prophetess Diane Chavez with Gospel Blimp Ministries. The choir opened up with songs. Apostle Ray and I each ministered in song. Evangelist Noe and Diane brought a mighty word from God. Many came up for prayer for different reasons. Some came to me saying in all the years they had been in prison they had never heard the word of God preached like that before and wanted more of this type of preaching. Praise God.

Jester IV unit On June 26th, 2022, Minister John Hammond and Dan Groves ministered to a group of 33 men.
