PRISON VISIT REPORTS

Clemens unit On July 3, 2022, we, Pastors Cynthia and Leonard Ventress, ministered at the Trustee Camp at the Clemens Unit in Brazoria, Texas. Thirty-three men were present to worship and receive the Word. After joining the Worship Team in anointed praise and worship, Pastor Leonard preached from the Book of Malachi, chapter 3, telling the men that we will all stand before a Mighty God to give account for what we have done on this earth, and what we have done with His Son, Jesus.

He told them that we all have freedom in Christ, that Christ died for all men, women, and children, and that regardless of our race or color, we are all brothers and sisters in Christ. He went on to say that soldiers, men and women of all colors have shed their blood on the battlefield, so that we can enjoy the rights and freedoms that we have here in the United States of America.

Pastor Leonard encouraged the men, reassuring them that if they are in fellowship with God the Father through Jesus the Son, that He is taking care of their families, their wives, and children, in their absence. He reiterated that "Who the Lord sets free is free indeed!"

We closed with prayer, then told the men that we look forward to seeing many of them in our weekly classes we will begin on Wednesday afternoons, beginning July 6.

Estelle unit On July 3rd, 2022, John Hammond & Dan Groves came and joined the men for 12:30 pm gathering. The 10:30am has been changed to 8am, but we learned too late. Dan Groves shared about sharing in your brothers sorrow and celebrating with him in his joy. John Hammond gave the message from Eph 4:15 concerning growing up in Jesus, and the Holy Spirit is talking to us always. Tune into the frequency of God. After, men came up asking for counsel, encouragement and prayer for their personal growth.

Diboll Unit, On July 24th Apostle Ray Felder and I attended the Diboll unit last Sunday. The room was filled to capacity so that they had to call and tell them not to release anymore because there were no more chairs. Apostle Ray preached from Psalm 23:1-6, his message was "He Restoreth My Soul". Many were prayed for collectively.
