Carol Vance Unit Saturday, Aug 13th John Hammond and Jason Perez ministered to the



inmates here. John led the worship with his guitar, as their worship team was not available for this service. Several testimonies were given by the inmates to start the service that blessed us all. Jason gave an encouraging word from Romans 12:2 to not be conformed to the world. I ministered on "God Is Good" from Psalm 34 and Genesis 1 and informed the men that even in their current situation they can

know the goodness of Jesus. There was time remaining when I completed my message, so we had a time of individual prayer, and more testimony from the men concerning how God is moving in their lives. The inmates in this unit are hungry to develop a closer relationship with Jesus and we all were aware of the Lord's Presence during the entire service.
