From CEO / Chaplain Shelia Johnson:

Hello friends and partners, I pray blessings and peace upon each of you in the name of Jesus the Christ. I would like to share a little about how the grace of God gives us as children of God advantages.

Grace Gives You The Advantage!

For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith. Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God? (1 John 5:4-5).

Abraham, after helping to defeat the enemies of Sodom refused to accept any compensation from the king of Sodom in spite of his persuasive words. In his words, "I will not take from a thread even to a shoe-latchet, and that I will not take any thing that is thine, lest thou shouldest say, I have made Abram rich" (Genesis 14:23). Abraham understood that there was nothing the king of Sodom could give to him that would compare to the advantage God had given him; he had a treasured relationship with God.

Remember, you're Abraham's seed, thus even in today's world where the global economy is failing, the fact that you're a child of grace puts you ahead. No wonder the Bible says "When men are cast down, then thou shalt say, There is lifting up..." (Job 22:29). That's because as a child of God you have the grace-advantage; it's the power of promotion; it causes your life to move from one level of glory to another.

God wants you to be conscious of the grace advantage! He wants you to know that you're the seed of Abraham, and that grace is working in you twenty-four hours a day! That grace puts you ahead and positions you for the glorious life like it did Isaac, who sowed in a time of famine, yet reaped a hundredfold harvest (Genesis 26:12-13), because grace gave him the advantage.
