## PRISON VISIT REPORTS

**Pam Lychner Unit** October 8<sup>th</sup>, Minister Dan Groves went into this unit and had 2 hours with 60 men. After Worship we were reminded that the Holy Spirit was manifest in our midst. Dan brought a message from the Word entitled EMPATHY from Romans 12:15, Prov 14:10 and others. Afterward I gave an invitation for prayer. One man received Jesus and one was prayed for healing. Bless The Lord, Dan Groves

**Stringfellow Trustee Camp** On the afternoon of October 8<sup>th</sup>, Minister Dan Groves went to this unit and ministered to about 15 men. Since there was a mix-up on times, this was a great turnout. I recognized some of the men and know they are dedicated disciples of Jesus. I sang Psalm 150 and we worshipped God together. I brought the same message as I had that morning at Pam Lychner. We were all blessed in the fellowship of the Holy Spirit.

**LeBlanc Unit,** On October 22<sup>nd</sup>, Minister Dan Groves went to this unit in Beaumont for the first time. As the men entered and signed in they began setting up extra chairs until the

entire room was packed. In the end, including wheelchairs and walkers lined up against two walls there were 103 men in attendance. I spoke on our mandate from Jesus to preach the Gospel both in word and through a holy life that would draw men to Jesus. In worship and throughout the meeting the air was electric with the Holy Spirit, which several of the men had taken note of. It was a most exhilarating time for all of us.

**Murray Unit Gatesville, Tx** *Chaplain Johnson, Apostle Ray C. Felder, and Dr. Cassandra Kitchen were at the Murray Unit in Gatesville Texas, a women's prison unit. The ladies each while holding hands in a circle prayed for the service, then the Chaplain prayed a powerful prayer before leaving to go to his church service. Some of the ladies praise dance on the song "You Know My Name" . The praise team sang a few songs. We ministered a few songs. Dr. Cassandra Kitchen ministered to the ladies with some very encouraging words. They were very receptive and before she could begin her message which was "Which gate will you choose, the straight and narrow or the wide and broad " Matt 7:14, her time was far spent. Many of the ladies came forward for prayer. One soul came to Christ and because of the strong anointing in the place yokes were broken. The guard stated that they had never had a service like that in all her years of being there.*
