PRISON VISIT REPORTS

Larry Gist Unit, On November 3, Chaplain Johnson, Dr. Kitchen, Apostle Felder and his wife Min. Johnnie Mae Felder attended the Gist unit in Beaumont, Texas. We are scheduled for two services at this unit.

Apostle Felder ministered on "Looking For Love in All the Wrong Places" **Jn 12; and Jn 3:16**. I ministered in the second service from **2 Cor 12:1-10**; "My Grace Is Sufficient".

Larry Gist Unit On November 24th we went back to the Gist unit and I ministered in the first service from **Matt 15:32-38**, "Being Thankful" and Apostle Felder ministered in the second service from **Ps 34:1-11**, "Oh Taste and See That the Lord Is Good". A total of 91 men were present. We had one back slider to return to the Lord and five souls accepted Christ as their savior. Praise be to God!!!

Clemens Trustee Camp on Sunday, December 1, 2024

My husband, Leonard, and I (Cynthia Ventress) were blessed to be able to bring a blessing to the men at the Clemens Unit in Brazoria in the form of doughnuts, hot chocolate, coffee, and the Word of God. The first men to come in got their hot doughnuts and drinks, and then a guard came in for count. She told them that if she counted them in the chapel, that they had to stay there until count was over. Well, some of the men had just come for doughnuts, but now they were stuck there for church. God works in mysterious ways. Leonard preached out of John Chapter 3 on how you must be Born Again. He told the men that no matter what they had done, that God would forgive them if they repented and put their faith in Jesus. Service was concluding, and quite a few came up for prayer. Since we had brought enough doughnuts for the whole camp, I sent someone outside to invite everyone in who did not come to church, to get a couple of doughnuts and a hot drink. And come they did! While these men were getting their doughnuts, others were receiving prayer. One in particular, really speaks to the plans and power of God. He came in at the beginning for a doughnut, and was one of the ones who did not come for church (or so he thought), but got stuck in there. He had heard the sermon about how Moses had killed a man and buried him, and how God still used him. He heard about our dear beloved friend, John Earl (who has gone on to be with the Lord) who was imprisoned in that very same prison for multiple life sentences, and was saved and set free both in the spirit, and in the natural world. When he came for prayer, he was crying. He told Leonard that he had never been in a church in his life. He said that he was in prison for manslaughter, and that he had no idea that God would forgive him. That man gave his heart and his soul to Christ, and put his faith in Jesus! He came for a doughnut, but also received the gift of eternal life with God. God works in mysterious ways. He came for a doughnut, got stuck because of count, and received Jesus! And he said, "I heard the message, and now I know that there is HOPE for ME!"
