PRISON VISIT REPORTS

Duncan Unit, Diboll, Tx. On 14th of Dec. Dan Groves went to this prison to be with the Church of 41 men located there. After worship, I shared, <u>'How Great Thou Art'</u> and the men joined in. The message was <u>Confidence in the Unseen</u>, from verses in Hebrews Chapt.11, with the example of Korah in Numbers 16. Dathan said, "will you put out the eyes of these men?"

Stringfellow SAFP On 15th of Dec. Dan Groves went to share with the men in this program. I was blessed to see about 19 men showed, even though my arrival was a complete surprise. The Holy Spirit shared about faith and faithfulness before I opened my notes on <u>Confidence in the Unseen.</u> After the message one man came for prayer about voices in his head. We prayed for deliverance for him and I gave him Philippians 4:8 (think on these things), to read often each day.


Editor's note:
