LARRY GIST UNIT- On May 4, 2025 I went to the Gist unit alone. I preached both services and in both services we had 127 men to attend. Some came up for prayer and some I prayed for because they were going home. Chaplain Shelia Johnson

DUNCAN UNIT: On May 10th, Janet Joyce & Dan Groves attended the 7pm service and after a glorious praise time, Janet gave a rousing message followed by Dan speaking on Practicing The Word.

Janet gave a word of encouragement to care for one another as brothers, watching out for signs you brother may need some care and encouragement. Dan Groves brought a word entitled: My redeeming God. After closing prayer, we had a little time for fellowship and individual prayer. We were blessed to have about 20 men who attended though they had church earlier.

LARRY GIST UNIT - May 25, Chap. S. Johnson, Min. J. Felder and Min. C. Kitchen went to Gist Unit in Beaumont, Tx. We opened the 11:00am service with praise and worship in which the men joined in. Chap. S. Johnson sang a couple of anointed worship songs which filled the room with the presence of the Lord. She then gave an amazing word entitled, "He Is Able", from Ephesians 3: 20-21. The men were up on their feet praising the Lord because they had found a new hope in the message. In total were 67 men. One gave his life to Christ and 1 rededicated his life.
