From CEO / Chaplain Shelia Johnson: Dear Partners and friends, on Tuesday of last week we were invited to go to Palestine, Texas and view ten acres of land for the Town of Hope, a vision God has given us. This property is owned by a pastor who wants the property to be used for God. Recently he has offered 10 acres to Hope For All for only 8,500 an acre. Saints, Brother Robert was given this vision in the '80's and the Lord gave me this same vision in 2000. He also shared this same vision with a Pastor friend of ours. We have partnered to pray together and see this vision come to fruition. We are asking for your help by giving toward this much needed task. The ex-offenders need a clean drug and alcohol free environment. Many can't be released because they have nowhere to be released to. They have no home, family, and the halfway houses are full. We need to help them Take the yoke of reproach off their lives. Neh 1:4 Fasting & prayer. I have learned that when we are willing to do with our hands people are more apt to give toward the work. The minute your hands go to work the atmosphere becomes agitated. People are used to us running our mouths but not moving our hands (faith without works). Nobody is intimidated by what you're saying as they are watching your hands (what you are doing) (faith with works). We are willing and ready to put our hands to work if you are willing to put your trust in what God is doing and give to a worthy cause. Focus must be a priority. Visioneer/leader authority. Are you willing to put your hands to the work of helping the vision of the "Town of Hope"come to fruition for the glory of God?

A Scripture to Stand on, Zech 8:3 Thus saith the LORD; I am returned unto Zion, and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and Jerusalem shall be called a city of truth; and the mountain of the LORD of hosts the holy mountain.

**CLEMENS TRUSTEE UNIT** On 3<sup>rd</sup> of August, Dan Groves went to this unit and joined the men for worship, after which I gave a message entitled <u>The fear of man Vs The fear of God</u>, in which I contrasted the many types of fear, trust, respect, reverence and belief people will either give to man and human institutions or God and His ways.

LARRY GIST UNIT- August 3, 2025- Chap. S. Johnson, Min. J. Felder, Dr. M. Kitchen, Elect Lady N. Young and Min. C. Kitchen went to Gist Unit in Beaumont, Tx. The other one is through CASH-APP. \$hfaij is the 'Cash-Tag' Both have been tested.


