Dear partners, & friends, February: A Fresh Start in the Ministry Behind Bars
As we step into February 2026, the chill of winter reminds us that renewal often comes from the coldest places. Our prison ministry stands as a beacon of Christ’s unchanging light in the darkest corners of society’s forgotten warehouses—the prisons. Here, where men and women are locked away from the world, we carry the gospel that breaks every chain, seen and unseen.

Despite the cultural noise of this month, we’re doubling down on our preaching to the inmates and encouraging them to build strong families upon release—large, faithful ones that defy the regime’s push for isolation and decay.

Your support fuels this fire. We’ve seen ex-inmates return to their communities as changed men: sober, married, fathers raising children in the fear of the Lord. But needs do grow—bibles wear out, study materials multiply, and travel costs rise. Prayer warriors, please intercede for open doors (Colossians 4:3).
