Estelle Unit: March 1st, Michael Woerner and I were privileged to flow in the presence of the Lord with 242 others. The anointed worship was provided by the Lighthouse choir. Michael provided a Word that motivated several men to come up for prayer. Emphasis on trusting God to provide for our every need, through the good days and the days of uncertainty

Stiles Unit, Beaumont- On March 1st, Pastor John H. & Dan Groves went to this unit and enjoyed spirit filled and passionate worship with this well organized and passionate Church. Dan gave a short word on Surrender. John preached on Developing your relationship with Jesus. Many came up for prayer and we joined the prayer warriors praying for quite some time. From the cross, *Dan Groves*

Gist Unit – March 1st, John & Dan came to this unit where John led the 11am service in praise ending with a good word of encouragement and Dan gave the full message about surrender. 5 men answered the call to salvation. In the 1:30 service, Pastor John gave the message, Making Jesus the center of your life's ambition.

Stringfellow Substance Abuse Felony Prison March 15, Janet Joice & Dan Groves came to this small congregation where we led the men in praise with a CD and song books. Janet rallied the men and gave an encouraging word, using her own life experiences. Dan gave the revised message on Surrender. How many came for prayer for healing and family issues, unknown.

Rufus Duncan Unit– March 14th, It was an emotional service with 41 people in attendance. Lots of prayer allowing God to take our burdens and trials that may distract us from God's purpose. As trials begin to weigh heavy on our walk with the Lord, there is power in prayer.(where 2 or more are gathered in His name). We took time to pray for Pastors, Worship leaders and Ministry leaders to avoid becoming Spiritual Roadkill. Encouraging service for all. *Janet Joyce*

LEBLANC UNIT, BEAUMONT, TX: March 22nd, Dan Groves and I ministered in the morning at this unit with approximately 60 men in attendance. The anointed worship team ushered in the presence of the Holy Spirit to start the service. I introduced Hope For All In Jesus Prison outreach and gave a word of encouragement. Dan gave the message "Our Future is Defined with our choice of words, that was well received by the men, and many came up for prayer after the message.

GIST UNIT, BEAUMONT, TX: March 22nd, We also minister at this unit later in the morning and early afternoon. I led the men in worship to open the service. Between the morning and afternoon service 91 men attended. Dan introduced the prison ministry and gave a word of encouragement. I gave the message "The Mind is the Battlefield" from 1 Corinthians 10:3-5. The men responded to message and 2 gave their lives to Lord during these services.
