Soup for the Soul:

A Charge to Stand Firm: The Virtue of the Unyielding

Today, we see institutions—once pillars of civilization—now crumbling because they have traded the granite foundation of objective truth (the Cross) for the shifting mud of secular convenience. In such times, the most radical act a Christian can perform is to stand firm.

Standing firm is not an act of mere stubbornness; it is an act of submission to the King. It is the recognition that because Christ is Lord of all, His truth is not a negotiable set of principles but an immutable law of existence. To “stand fast in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free” (**Gal 5:1, KJV**) requires us to reject the cowardice that masquerades as “tolerance” or “nuance.” We are to be like the house built upon the rock, which, when the storms descended and the floods came, “beat vehemently upon that house, and could not shake it: for it was founded upon a rock” (**Lk 6:48, KJV**). Let your posture be one of immovable, quiet, and terrifying certainty. Do not back down from the truth, even when it is costly. (**1 Cor 15:58**)
