MARK W. STILES UNIT - July 05, 2026-Chaplain Shelia Johnson, Min. Johnnie M. Felder and Min. Cassandra Kitchen went to Mark W. Stiles Unit in Beaumont, Texas. There were 156 men in attendance. The inmates opened with scripture, prayer, praise and worship. Chaplain Johnson brought a powerful Word from **1 John 3: 1-2** entitled **“When I See Jesus.”** There were five men who came to give their life to Christ and many backsliders. Also, many came up for prayer. God Bless—Cassandra Kitchen

CLEMENS UNIT- July 05, 2026- The Lord blessed us with the opportunity to bring breakfast tacos for all of the men at the Trustee Camp at the Clemens Unit, in honor of the 4th of July. They were truly blessed! The workers at the restaurant opened early to make 400 tacos! They started cooking at 5:00 am! They (Puerta Vallarta Mexican Restaurant in Angleton, Texas) were kind enough to send catering containers, so that the tacos arrived hot at the unit.

God really wanted to show the men how much he loves them, and they were feeling the love! One man stated that his wife had made him homemade tortillas and breakfast tacos for 23 years, and this touched him in a spiritual way. Another man from San Antonio said that he felt right at home. Another declared that he was amazed that they got “Free World Tacos”.

With their bellies full, it was time for them to receive the spiritual food. Leonard preached from **John Chapter 3**, on **“The Greatest Gift of Love: Jesus.”** About **50** men stayed for the church service. Everywhere you looked, there were smiles. At the time for altar call and prayer, at least **10** men came up to pray with the prayer partners. We encouraged them to continue to seek Jesus on a personal, daily basis.
